He received his Masters Degree in School Psychology from Hofstra University on Long Island, NY. He received his Ph.D. in Social Psychology from State University of NY at Albany. He worked as a School Psychologist in New York and then had a private practice in New York, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, and California.

He began his career in biofeedback in 1975. His early computerization of biofeedback led him to be declared a Pioneer in Computerized biofeedback by the Association for Applied Psychophysiology and Biofeedback.

After 15 years of experience using all forms of biofeedback he began to specialize in neurofeedback. In 1990 he discovered a way to accelerate the response to neurofeedback, to begin to turn neurofeedback into a tool that can more rapidly bring improvements in cognition, movement, emotional control, and pain. The trainings and work he initiated have been carried on by hundreds of others. It is said to be responsible for the improvements in functioning of over 80,000 individuals as of 2008, out of perhaps 100,000 clients treated by with this system.
